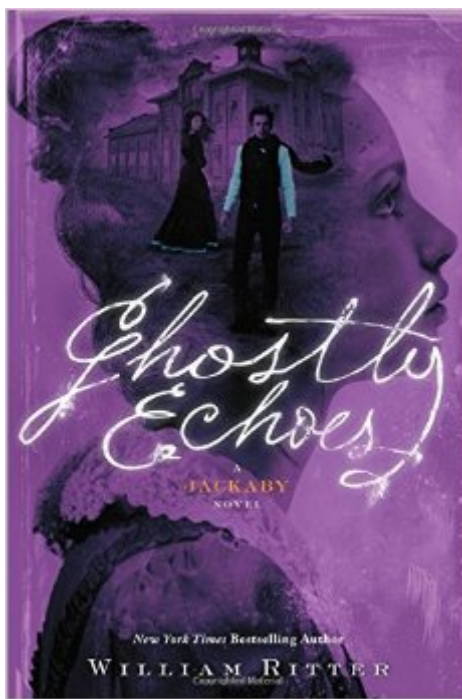

Jenny and Abigail's characters have grown marvelously since first meeting in Jackaby, and this story gives a great view of the bond and friendship they have formed over their time together. Detectives are usually hard to read or understand and Jackaby is no exception to that case, but in this installment the reader is allowed a glimpse of the man behind the name of R.F. Jackaby. Being a big mystery all on his own, the author giving a glimpse into Jackaby's past and more of his present self made his character more relatable and gave new meanings to a few of his actions. Abigail and Jackaby's relationship has been my favorite since picking up the first book. Too close to be employer/employee, but not at all romantic- it seems like Jackaby could almost be a friend of Abigail's older brother. He's caring in his own way, but always leaves the ultimate decision up to Abigail- she is smart and can think for herself, after all.
